

2022 Youth Art Competition Rules & Regulations

Our efforts to provide a fun and safe Youth Art Competition is still underway. In the event of another spike in Coronavirus cases or another variant arising however, we will notify all participants of any award ceremony cancellation. Due to COVID-19, ArtiGras has taken and implemented all guidelines provided by the CDC. Please see the information below for more details. Celebrate the 37th anniversary of ArtiGras Fine Arts Festival on **February 19 & 20, 2022** as we invite Palm Beach County schools to participate and submit their students' artwork to the Youth Art Competition!

The theme of this year's ArtiGras Youth Art Competition is *Garden Party*. Have your students create their own piece of art centered around what Garden Party means to them Student's artwork can be inspired by Alice in Wonderland, or it can reflect what makes a party fun to them, what they love about nature, or they can recreate their own garden. We ask for <u>all</u> of the artwork to incorporate the theme in some way, but the interpretation is completely up to the artist!

The ArtiGras Youth Art Competition is a juried art competition, for grade levels K-12 that features award money to the winning students and schools. Each school in Palm Beach County may submit <u>ONE PIECE</u> of artwork <u>FROM EACH GRADE LEVEL</u> into the competition. All artwork is due by Thursday, December 16, 2021. Details regarding the drop-off and pick-up areas are below.

All artwork submitted to the ArtiGras Youth Art Competition will be judged, and judges will choose five (5) winners from each grade, including: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners and two (2) honorable mentions. We also have a "Best of Show" for one Elementary, Middle and High School student. Each student, age 12 or under, who submits artwork will receive two tickets to the festival, as well as art teachers submitting artwork. Each student age 13 or older will receive three (3) tickets to the festival. Kids 12 and under are free to attend the festival.

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES & POLICIES:

DEADLINE: Artwork must be dropped off at one of the designated drop-off locations by **Thursday, December 16, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.** This deadline will enable us to publish participating schools in the media.

ARTWORK FORMATS: All artwork **must** fit within the following formats:

- Any 2-D medium (watercolor, oil, ink, clay pencil, photography, etc.) may be used
- Artwork sizes are: minimum 8 1/2" x 11" and maximum 12" x 18" not including the matting (if any)
- The completed release form <u>must</u> be attached/pasted to the back of each entry
- Do not laminate or frame artwork
- All artwork must be mounted or matted <u>AND</u> wrapped for outdoor protection

AWARDS:

Five (5) awards will be given in each grade level: 1st Place, 2nd Place, 3rd Place, and two (2) Honorable Mentions. All honorable mentions and award winners will receive an ArtiGras Awards Ribbon. The "Best of Show" winner will receive an additional \$100 check in their name. In addition, each of these winners will be on display at ArtiGras both days on February 19 & 20 2022.

Schools with winning students will also receive prize money to further their art programs. **Prize money for the schools is awarded as follows:**

- Best in Show students and their schools receive \$100 each
- 1st Place winning students and their schools receive \$90 each

- 2nd Place winners' school receives \$75
- 3rd Place winners' school receives \$50



- <u>Artwork submitted by home schools will not be accepted</u>. The mission of the Youth Art Competition is to support school art programs in local Palm Beach County Schools.
- All entries and artist's details (name, city and state) may be used in publicity campaigns for this promotion and future promotions.
- The decision of the Youth Art Jury is final.
