

# 2024 Hanley Foundation Youth Art Competition Rules & Regulations

Celebrate the 39<sup>th</sup> anniversary of ArtiGras Fine Arts Festival on **February 17 & 18, 2024** as we invite Palm Beach County schools to participate and submit their students' artwork to the Hanley Foundation Youth Art Competition! <u>We've made some changes to the rules, so please be sure to thoroughly read all the way</u> <u>through the Rules & Regulations.</u>

The theme of this year's ArtiGras Youth Art Competition is *An Artistic Journey*. In your students' own way, have them create artwork of what *An Artistic Journey* means to them. We encourage students to experiment with new methods & materials. Students could reflect on a journey they've taken in their life, their art, or something totally abstract! We ask for ALL of the artwork to incorporate the theme in some way, but the interpretation is completely up to the artist!

The Hanley Foundation Youth Art Competition is a juried art competition, for grade levels K-12 that features award money to the winning students and schools. Each school in Palm Beach County may submit <u>ONE PIECE</u> of artwork <u>FROM EACH GRADE LEVEL</u> into the competition. All artwork is due by Monday, December 11, 2023. Details regarding the drop-off and pick-up areas are below.

All artwork submitted to the Hanley Foundation Youth Art Competition will be judged, and judges will choose five (5) winners from each grade, including: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners and two (2) honorable mentions. There will also be a "Best of Show" category, in which we will have one Elementary, one Middle and one High School student winner. Each student aged 12 or under who submits artwork will receive two (2) tickets to the festival, as well as art teachers submitting artwork. Each student aged 13 or older will receive three (3) tickets to the festival. Kids 12 and under are free to attend the festival.

## **OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES & POLICIES:**

**DEADLINE:** Artwork must be dropped off at one of the designated drop-off locations by **Monday, December 11, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.** This deadline will enable us to publish participating schools in the media.

**ARTWORK FORMATS:** All artwork **must** fit within the following formats:

- Any 2-D medium (watercolor, oil, ink, clay pencil, photography, etc.) may be used
- Artwork sizes are **minimum 8 ½" x 11" and maximum 12"x 18**" not including the matting (if any)
- The completed release form **must** be **attached/pasted to the back** of each entry
- Do not laminate or frame artwork
- All artworks must be mounted or matted <u>AND</u> wrapped for outdoor protection

#### AWARDS:

Five (5) awards will be given in each grade level: 1<sup>st</sup> Place, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place, and two (2) Honorable Mentions. All honorable mentions and award winners will receive an ArtiGras Awards Ribbon. The "Best of Show" winner will also receive a \$100 check in their name. <u>At this time, we are only able to award checks to students who win "Best of Show" or first 1<sup>st</sup> place. In addition, each of these winners will be on display at the Hanley Foundation Youth Art Competition area both days on February 17 & 18, 2024.</u>

Schools with winning students will also receive prize money to further their art programs. **Prize money for the** schools is awarded as follows:

- Best in Show students and their schools receive \$100 each
- 1<sup>st</sup> Place winning students and their schools receive \$90 each
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place winners' <u>school receives</u> \$75
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place winners' <u>school receives</u> \$50

#### ARTWORK PICK UP:

All artwork will be available for pick up after the awards ceremony in the ArtiKids Zone on Sunday, February 18<sup>th</sup>. Artwork must be checked out by the student or parent or guardian of the student. We cannot let artwork go with parents or guardians of other students unless previously approved. If your student's parent/guardian would like someone else to pick up the artwork, they can contact Caitlyn Bergman at <u>Caitlyn@pbnchamber.com</u> by <u>Friday, February 9<sup>th</sup>.</u>

Artwork that is not picked up at the festival can be picked up at the Palm Beach North Chamber of Commerce office <u>between</u> Tuesday, February 20 and Thursday, March 7, 2024. Pickup times are Monday – Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Any artwork not picked up by Friday, March 8, 2024, at 3:00 p.m. will be donated to local organizations at the discretion of the Palm Beach North Chamber of Commerce.

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- <u>Artwork submitted by home schools will not be accepted</u>. The mission of the Youth Art Competition is to support school art programs in local Palm Beach County Schools.
- All entries and artist's details (name, city, and state) may be used in publicity campaigns for this promotion and future promotions.
- The decision of the Youth Art Jury is final.
